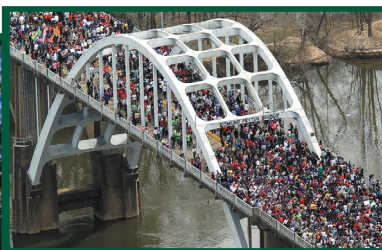


Civil Rights 5 Day Tour • New Orleans, LA - Atlanta, GA
